The FoodCycler is Here!







The Municipality is pleased to share that Wawa is participating in the FoodCycler Pilot Food Waste Diversion Program. The FoodCycler is an appliance approximately the size of a home bread machine that breaks down residential food waste by 90% and makes it easier to compost aiming to reduce organics heading to our landfill. Food waste that is sent with household garbage to landfill sites reduces landfill capacity and releases greenhouse gas emissions. The Pilot Program will last 12 weeks and up to 100 households will be eligible to participate. The Municipality of Wawa's available tax sale includes six properties. These properties consist of house, commercial and vacant land. Tenders are invited for the purchase of the lands described below and will be received until 3:00 p.m. local time on March 27, 2024, at the Town Hall, 40 Broadway Avenue, Wawa Ontario.

The tenders will then be opened in public on the same day as soon as possible after 3:00 p.m. at the Town Hall, 40 Broadway Avenue, Wawa. Tenders must be submitted in the prescribed form and must be accompanied by a deposit of at least 20 per cent of the tender amount, which deposit shall be made by way of a certified cheque/bank draft/money order payable to the municipality. The successful purchaser will be required to pay the amount tendered plus accumulated taxes and any taxes that may be applicable, such as a land transfer tax and HST. A copy of the prescribed form of tender is available on the website of the Government of Ontario Central Forms Repository under the listing
