

**THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF MICHIPICOTEN**

BY-LAW NO. 937-94

BEING A BY-LAW to regulate the discharge of guns or other firearms within the Township of Michipicoten.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, Section 210, Paragraph 36, states that by-laws may be passed by the councils of local municipalities for the purpose of public safety, for prohibiting or regulating the discharge of guns or other firearms, air-guns, spring-guns, cross-bows, long-bows or any class or type thereof in the municipality or in any defined areas thereof;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to regulate and control the discharge of any gun or other firearm within the Township of Michipicoten;

NOWTHEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Michipicoten enacts the following as a By-Law:

1. THAT no person shall discharge any gun or other firearm, air-gun, spring-gun, cross-bow, long-bow or any class or type thereof within the following designated areas:
 - (a) the Townsite of Wawa;
 - (b) an area within one mile of the Townsite of Wawa;
 - (c) within any built-up area within the Township of Michipicoten, including the Michipicoten River Village, Michipicoten Harbour and High Falls; and
 - (d) within a safe distance from any occupied building or dwelling within the Township of Michipicoten.

2. THAT Section 1 shall not apply:
 - (a) for an approved outdoor shooting range; and
 - (b) for shooting galleries within the confines of a building where proper safety precautions are observed, except in the matter of handguns which require an authorized range.

3. Every person who contravenes any provision of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction to a fine that is consistent with the general penalty provision found under the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.33, as amended.
4. THAT Township of Michipicoten By-Law No. 2-68 be and is hereby repealed.

READ a first time this 7th day of June, 1994.

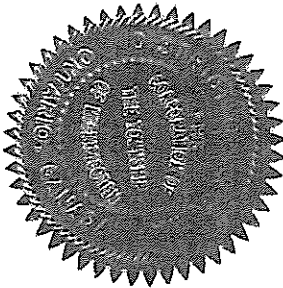


