Purpose

The purpose of this report is to provide Council with an overview of the Infrastructure Services work completed during the month of August 2023.

Airport Operations

- Interviewed Airport Attendant applicant; and
- Summer students have completed their term.

Landfill Operations

- SMS in Timmins assisted with repairs to the Bomag machine. However, there are still technical issues with the equipment, including waiting on components for air conditioning unit; and
- Two steel bins have been taken away this month.

Road Operations

- Summer students completed their summer term;
- Hired mechanic for shop, start date is scheduled for mid-September;
- Continued routine maintenance of gravel roads;
- Continued line painting for streets, parking lots and crosswalks;
- Cold patched sections of road throughout town; and
- Began sidewalk replacement projects.

Water and Sewer Operations

- Requested funding for emergency purchase of 3 HDPE feed tanks for filter skids;
- Mixer at water tower had become severed from its connection and was recovered using ROV equipment;
- Unexpected PLC failure caused pressure drop in distribution system, worked in coordination with SAC, MECP and APH to ensure water was safe for public consumption; and

- Continued ongoing distribution and collection system maintenance.

Capital Projects

- Intake Project – a contractor was hired to complete a ROV inspection of the water intake and will be returned in August due to technical difficulties.
- Landfill Expansion – deficiencies with the expansion project are being addressed.
- Roll-Off Truck – Roll Off Truck has arrived, been safetied, is awaiting emissions test.
- Mini-Excavator and Trailer – arrived at the beginning of August and have been used in the cemetery for expansion site clearing and for sidewalk projects.
- Cemetery – Municipal Staff have been diligently brushing the expansion site and existing cemetery fencing. Project is set to go out for tender in September.
- SUV – the Assistant Director of Infrastructure Services SUV is due to arrive in September.
- Airport funding round II application has been submitted for terminal upgrades and sand dome.

Month Ahead

Forecasted for September:

- Clean up of summer equipment
- Brushing around major infrastructure
- Road rehabilitation
- Cemetery maintenance and expansion
- Continue sidewalk repairs
- Water/ Sewer regular maintenance
- Delivery of SUV
- Water Operator exam preparation course and writing level 1 exams
